INDOOR RANGE RULES & SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 1. It is mandatory that each member sign in and out in the register book located in the range. Please print name, range pass number and time in and out.
- 2. Members are allowed to bring one guest, at a time, at a cost of \$10.00 per guest. Guests are allowed on the first weekend (Saturday and Sunday) of each month between Noon and 2:00 p.m. Any guest MUST sign the register book and must use member's shooting port.
- 3. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES** shall be consumed prior to entering the range, **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES** shall be brought into the range. Anyone under the influence of alcohol or any other substance or deemed by the appropriate authority to be under the influence of any alcohol or drug shall be barred from entering the range. Any abuse or misuse of this rule shall be grounds for indefinite loss of range pass.
- 4. All firearms when entering the club shall be in a closed container and unloaded. NO firearms, at any times on club property, shall be carried in a holster or out in plain site in the bar/seating area.

 VIOLATION REQUIRES FORFEIT OF RANGE PASS.
- 5. All firearms displayed or handled behind the firing line must be unloaded and must have the action open at all times. NO loaded firearm shall be left unattended on the firing line or ports.
- 6. All firearms on the line must be pointed downrange at all times; specifically avoid pointing firearms at ceiling and keep your finger off the trigger until your firearm is pointed at the target. When clearing a jam, keep firearm pointed down range.
- 7. There will be NO trick shooting or shooting at a target other than the one assigned to your shooting station.
- 8. All shooters and spectators must conduct themselves in an orderly manner, keeping noise and other distractions to an absolute minimum. The rights of other shooters and spectators must be respected at all times. Any suggestive remarks made MAY RESULT IN FORFEIT OF RANGE PASS.
- 9. Eye and ear protection must be worn by all personnel on the range while firing is in progress. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- 10. No individual shall handle any firearm while any person is in front of the firing line. NO ONE shall go forward of the line until a "CEASE FIRE" has been called and line has been made safe.
- 11. Any individual is expected to call "CEASE FIRE" immediately upon observation of any unsafe condition. Any "CEASE FIRE" must be obeyed instantly.
- 12. There will be NO firing of the barricade position from the firing ports.
- 13. There will be NO setting up of targets in the sand or on the railroad ties.
- 14. No full-sized human silhouette targets are allowed at any time.
- 15. NO smoking in firing range or ports.
- 16. NO armor-piercing or incendiary ammunition is allowed. NO exploding targets are allowed.
- 17. NO shotguns or center-fire rifles; this includes those chambered for handgun cartridges. NO handguns chambered for rifle cartridges or shotgun cartridges.
- 18. Report any and all breakage of equipment to range officer or bartender on duty.
- 19. All caliber firearms from 22LR to 45 MAG may be used; lead, ball or JHP.
- **20.** Clean up after yourself. Put used brass in proper containers.
- 21. DO NOT EXIT BY SIDE DOOR.

VIOLATIONS OF ANY OF THE ABOVE RULES COULD COST YOU YOUR RANGE PASS AND SHOOTING PRIVILEGES, PER ORDER OF THE RANGE COMMITTEE.
