### **YOUTH INDOOR RANGE RULES & SAFETY REGULATIONS**

1. It is mandatory that each youth and parent or guardian sign a Ludlow Fish and Game Club Liability Waiver each time a youth enters the range (unless the youth has their own active range pass).
2. It is mandatory that each youth sign in and out in the register book located in the range. Please print name, range pass number of your parent or guardian and time in and out.
3. Minimum age to use the range is 12 years old.
4. Youth 12-14 can only shoot .22lr rifles in the range – No Pistols/Handguns.
5. Youth 15-17 may shoot Pistols or Rifles.
6. Youth are not allowed to bring guests or spectators.
7. **Youth must be supervised by the attending parent or guardian within the shooting port unless the youth has their own active range pass.**
8. Youth with valid FIDs can obtain a range pass allowing them to shoot along side their parent or guardian.
9. Youth must observe all range rules. Failure to do so may result in the parent or guardian forfeiting their current range pass. No range pass fee will be refunded.
10. Any abuse or misuse of the range shall be grounds for the parent or guardian forfeiting their current range pass. No range pass fee will be refunded.
11. Youth, parents and guardians consent to be video recorded upon entering the range.
12. All firearms when entering the Club shall be in a closed container and unloaded. Failure to do so may result in the parent or guardian forfeiting their current range pass. No range pass fee will be refunded.
13. All firearms displayed or handled behind the firing line must be unloaded and must have the action open at all times. NO loaded firearm shall be left unattended on the firing line or ports.
14. All firearms on the line must be pointed downrange at all times; specifically avoid pointing firearms at ceiling and keep your finger off the trigger until your firearm is pointed at the target. When clearing a jam, keep firearm pointed down range.
15. There will be NO trick shooting or shooting at a target other than the one assigned to your shooting station.
16. All youth must conduct themselves in an orderly manner, keeping noise and other distractions to an absolute minimum. The rights of other shooters and spectators must be respected at all times. Any suggestive remarks made may result in the parent or guardian forfeiting their current range pass. No range pass fee will be refunded.
17. Eye and ear protection must be worn by all personnel on the range while firing is in progress. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
18. No individual shall handle any firearm while any person is in front of the firing line. NO ONE shall go forward of the line until a “CEASE FIRE” has been called and line has been made safe.
19. Any individual is expected to call “CEASE FIRE” immediately upon observation of any unsafe condition. Any “CEASE FIRE” must be obeyed instantly.
20. There will be NO setting up of targets in the sand or on the railroad ties.
21. No full-sized human silhouette targets are allowed at any time.
22. Report any and all breakage of equipment to Range Committee Member or bartender on duty.
23. All shooters will clean up after shooting. Put used brass in proper containers.
24. DO NOT EXIT BY SIDE DOOR.

**VIOLATIONS OF ANY OF THE ABOVE RULES COULD COST YOU YOUR RANGE PASS AND SHOOTING PRIVILEGES, PER ORDER OF THE RANGE COMMITTEE.**
